

MATHEMATICS, MINOR IN

A minor in mathematics consists of at least 18 credits (and a minimum of five courses) offered by the Department of Mathematics and Applied Mathematics, including the following:

Courses in subjects areas other than MATH cannot be applied to the minor. A minimum GPA of 2.0 must be achieved in the minor. A minimum of three credits must be taken at VCU. Students in the mathematical sciences majors cannot minor in mathematics.
