INTERNATIONAL SOCIAL JUSTICE STUDIES, MINOR IN

The international social justice studies minor consists of 18 credits. A minimum of 12 credits must be earned at the upper (300- or 400-) level.

Students must complete a minimum of three credits of foreign language course work at the advanced level (300 or above).

Courses marked "when appropriate" require preapproval from the School of World Studies Advising Office.
